

03.- North of Spain

A fabulous tour through the best mountain roads in Spain, which includes three magnificent coastal cities.



This tour every year is among the first three places in the valuation of our clients, so we can say that it is one of their favourites. They are not lacking in reasons, because it is an almost perfect tour.

On the biker side, the tour is wonderful, with fantastic secondary roads, perfectly paved, full of curves, (6,816 curves on the basic route), and very little traffic.

As for landscapes, this tour combines medium and low mountain roads, but many of them surrounded by high mountains, a good number of canyons of great beauty, green meadows, and the beautiful Cantabrian coast.

In terms of accommodation, on this tour we can offer you some truly exceptional hotels, some of them on the edge of the beach, combined with historical buildings and even a hotel in the middle of the Picos de Europa



natural park, with a cable car at its side that will allow you to comfortably climb to the top of the mountain where there are spectacular views, (and being in Spain, of course, a bar).

It is not too monumental trip to be a travel through Spain, since it does not spend the night in cities that are especially relevant from the historical point of view, but it does pass some architectural gems such as Burgos Cathedral or the Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao.

On the other hand, what it can boast of is that it is the tour with the best combined gastronomy of all the tours that can be done in Europe, and we dare say that in the world. Let us explain to you what we mean by this concept of combined gastronomy, so that you better understand what this tour can offer you like no other. There are two ways of understanding gastronomy, the first, whose great reference is the Michelin guide with its famous stars, is to look at the level of haute cuisine and thus assess the presence of Michelin stars throughout the trip, in this regard this tour It has an excellent level, but there are tours in France or Italy with better levels in this regard. The second is to look at the level of quality and, very importantly, VARIETY, in everyday food, that is, in what we are going to find without having to go to a great restaurant and spend a lot of money, and in this sense, this tour has no rival, neither in Europe, nor in the world. Combining both views, the rating of this tour would be the highest of all our tours.

STAGES OF THE TRIP

The tour has a MINIMUM DURATION of 7 days of motorcycle travel and the stages of what we call BASIC ROUTE would be:

Stage 1.- Madrid – Lerma.- 346 km in 5:34 hours with 969 curves.- An excellent stage crossing beautiful forests through an area very unknown even to most Spaniards. We will also offer you 4 shorter alternatives with riding time from 5:07 until 1:59 hours.



Stage 2.- Lerma – Fuente Dé.- 283 km in 4:51 hours with 773 curves.- An excellent stage that ends in a hotel located in the center of the natural park that has a cable car that allows you to climb to the top. We will also offer you 4 shorter alternatives with riding time from 4:29 until 3:06 hours.

Stage 3.- Fuente Dé – Gijón.- 277 km in 6:07 hours with 1457 curves.- This is the great stage of the Picos de Europa in which you will ride along some of the best roads in Europe to finish at the edge of the sea. We will also offer you 9 shorter alternatives with riding time from 5:37 until 2:15 hours.



Stage 4.- Gijón – Santander.- 315 km in 5:20 hours with 942 curves.- Another excellent route that runs through the northern area of the Picos de Europa, ending at Santander, one of the most beautiful cities in Spain. We will also offer you 8 shorter alternatives with riding time from 5:20 until 1:54 hours.

Stage 5.- Santander – San Sebastián.- 244 km in 4:34 hours with 773 curves.-

A transitional stage with a great cultural visit, The Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao, but including one of the most beautiful coastal roads in Spain. We will also offer you 5 shorter alternatives with riding time from 4:15 until 2:26 hours.



Stage 6.- San Sebastián – Elciego.- 315 km in 6:03 hours with 1131 curves.

Excellent route through the beautiful roads of the Basque country ending in La Rioja, where you can choose your destination between Elciego, Santo Domingo or Logroño. We will also offer you 8 shorter alternatives with riding time from 5:45 until 2:09 hours.



Stage 7.- Elciego – Madrid.- 405 km in 5:58 hours with 771 curves.-

The last stage crosses the mountains of the Iberian system and then goes through the same forest area that the first stage travelled, but by different roads. We will also offer you 6 shorter alternatives with riding time from 5:06 until 2:45 hours.



In the following table you can see the summary of the stages, with the distances, riding times, number of curves and duration of the 5 most important alternative routes, although it may be the case that we offer more than 5 alternatives.

Note that we are talking about real riding time, that is, the time that you will be riding with the motorcycle. To this duration you should add the time you spend taking photos, refuelling, eating or drinking something, etc. However, we already take this factor into account and if a stage is going to have many visits, we shorten its riding.

The number of curves will give you an idea of the type of roads the route takes, but we recommend that you read the article ["Why do we count curves?"](#) that you will find by clicking on the link that will take you to our website.

As you have seen, at all stages we place special emphasis on the fact that we are going to offer you several shorter alternatives. The reason for this is that our complete routes are very intense and require a good level of driving and good weather conditions. If this is not the case, being able to have shorter alternatives, and therefore simpler, with fewer curves and on more main roads, can be very useful. But obviously reducing a stage has a cost in terms of quality. For this reason and for you to have an element of judgment when choosing the alternative that you are going to use in the road book, we are going to present you, along with the maps and links to Google Maps of all the alternatives, the following Table:

In the example we have a complete route and 5 alternatives, being the 5th the shortest one, as we are going to present it to you. As you will see, as the stage is shortened, the quality is reduced because intermediate points are eliminated and therefore good sections of road. In the last column we show you the ratio that measures, in relative terms, quality and time. With this example, the optimal option would be Alt. 1, since it reduces more time, (12%) than quality, (10%)

TRIP EXTENSIONS:

If you can have more days to make this trip, we recommend that you add one or more of the 5 extensions that we are going to show you below:



Extension A.- Adding an EXCURSION TO SOMIEDO NATURAL PARK.- A highly recommended extension since the Somiedo Natural Park area is one of the most beautiful in Asturias and its roads, full of curves, and with very little traffic, are perfect for enjoying the motorcycle.



Extension B.- EXCURSION TO BIARRITZ.- During the 19th century, Biarritz was the preferred summer resort for royal families and European aristocracies. In addition, including this extension will give you the opportunity to enjoy San Sebastianian gastronomy one more day.

Extension C.- Adding an STOPOVER IN BILBAO.- Bilbao is the main city in the Basque Country, and therefore also has a fabulous gastronomic offer. In addition, this extension will allow you to know the roads of the Basque mountains, which are wonderful.



Extension D.- DIVERT the trip TO SIGÜENZA.- The reason for this extension is to explore the magnificent roads of the Iberian System in greater depth, but also Sigüenza is a nice city, with great historical heritage in which its castle, where you can sleep, stands up.

Extension E.- Adding a REST DAY IN SANTANDER.- Right in the center of the trip you will arrive in Santander, which is a city

that has an excellent beach, and excellent gastronomy, so it is a highly recommended place to spend a rest day in the middle of the trip.

Extension F.- Adding a REST DAY IN SAN SEBASTIAN.- If you are fond of gastronomy, the offer of San Sebastián is so wide that you will most likely want to spend another day to get to know it in greater depth.



Schematically it would be:

In this way, on the basic route of 7 days you can add, as you want, the extra days that you consider appropriate and adjust the trip to suit you. For example, you could configure an 10 days trip by adding to the basic version the extensions A, E & F, that is, the Excursion to Somiedo, and the rest days in Santander and San Sebastian.

The fact of being able to combine the extra days at will means that the total of configurations of this tour that we can offer is 64, which are the possible combinations of the trip plus the extra days. Having so many options to choose from can make it difficult for you to decide on one of them, so we have arranged the travel extensions in the order in which we would add them. In this way we would add extension A first, then B, and so on, but of course you have the last word, and you can add the extensions as you prefer.

When ordering the extensions we take into account more factors than simply seeing which extension is better. In the case of this tour, as you will see, we put the rest day in Santander ahead of the one in San Sebastian. Does this mean that we prefer the city of Santander to that of San Sebastian? And the answer is no. What happens is that the extension of the excursion to Biarritz already implies one more day in San Sebastian, so the rest day would already be the third night, and that is why we prefer a second night in Santander than a third night in San Sebastian.

If you added all the extensions to the trip, it would last 13 days and the table of the route would be the following:

CLIMATOLOGY AND OPTIMAL SEASON:

The Iberian Peninsula is in the extreme southwest of Europe, so it enjoys one of the best climates on the continent, but the north of Spain is quite rainy, that's why it is so green, and especially in Galicia, so this is a tour on it is probably going to rain. But in summer, the rain is usually punctual, and although it rains often, it does not do it all day, so if you check the weather forecasts daily, it is very possible that you can avoid riding in the rain during the whole trip. Regarding the best season, from the weather point of view, to make this trip, in the following table you will find the list of the months and the weather conditions that should be found on average, as well as our assessment of each month.

PRICES:

Unlike the other companies of Motorcycle Tours, we give you the freedom to hire the motorcycle with us or in another company and, in the same way, we give you the option that you book your hotels or that we take care of the reservation of the same.

ROUTE PRICES:

What we will always give you is route planning, which includes the following:

1.- Very detailed Road Book in PDF format.- In this PDF you will have all the information of each day of travel, including a brief description of the places of interest that you are going to find during the trip.

2.- Recommended daily route created by professionals.- Our routes are the fruit of more than 10 years of professionally planning motorcycle trips.

3.- Very careful selection of intermediate points.- The vast majority of intermediate points, which are necessary to create the route, contribute something more and are places of interest, such as monuments, viewpoints to beautiful landscapes, bars where you can have a drink. coffee, etc ..

4.- Planning of fuel management.- Every 300 km at most, we will include a gas station, so that you don't worry about managing your fuel.

5.- Shorter Alternative Routes.- Our recommended routes are long enough to satisfy the most demanding pilot, but we understand that not all of our clients want to do such long routes every day. For this reason, we will send you several shorter alternative routes so that you can choose the one that best suits your preferences.

6.- Links of all the routes to Google Maps.- If you use your phone as a navigator, these links will allow you to see the route on it.

7.- GPX file to load in the Navigator.- If, on the contrary, you prefer to use a GPS navigator, the GPX file will allow you to load all the waypoints in it in a few minutes.

The price of the route, (including taxes), depends on the version you prefer, (number of days) according to the following table:

These prices, which already include taxes, are the amount we charge for our service of sending you the route information and it is for the entire group, so if you come with other friends you can share this cost with them.

MOTORCYCLE RENTAL PRICES:

We can also take care of the reservation of your motorcycle. We do not have our own motorcycles, but we work exclusively with companies in which we have full confidence and that must meet demanding requirements regarding the condition of the motorcycle, customer service and non-abusive damage policy, (in this aspect we pay special attention to attention). As we work with different companies, we do not have a fixed price for the motorcycle rental, since the different companies have different prices, but we will always offer you the maximum number of possible options, indicating at all times the motorcycle model, its year of registration and the characteristics of the contract; (type of insurance, value of the deposit, etc.), so that you can choose the one that best suits your preferences. On the other hand, the rental price of motorcycles also depends on several factors such as the date of your tour, the number of days, the mileage, the advance with which you make the reservation, (this aspect is very important), and the number of motorcycles that make up your group. For information purposes, in the following table you can see the models available in **Madrid** and their minimum price per day:

Elciego.- A spectacular hotel by the famous architect Frank Gehry.

Sigüenza.- An 8th century Arab fortress become into a Christian castle in the 15th century.
